

REQUEST FOR CONSIDERATION
WISCONSIN PERMEABLE PAVEMENT MONITORING STUDY
SYCAMORE PARK - MADISON, WI

The Wisconsin Standards Oversight Council (SOC) is looking for permeable pavement system representatives interested in participating in a monitoring study starting in 2019. This study is designed to provide information to develop and refine criteria for WDNR Conservation Practice Standard “Permeable Pavement” (1008). Interested representatives should contact DNR (Pete Wood, 262-884-2360, Peter.Wood@Wisconsin.gov) and then submit the following information to SOC by September 1, 2018:

1. Contact information for the system representative (name, address, phone number, e-mail).
2. Description of the system features and applications (potential markets).
3. Confirmation that the representative will install the system in the assigned test cell in 2019 (~ May 1st). See page 2 for test cell dimensions.
4. Verification that the system complies with criteria found in DNR permeable pavement technical standard 1008.
5. Diagram (cross-section) of the system.
6. Existing research papers and monitoring data for the system.

NOTE: Anyone conducting work to install an accepted system at the permeable pavement test site must be prequalified by the City of Madison to work on City property or within the public right-of-way (prequalified contractor). Each installation or work activity at the permeable pavement test site will require that a permit to Excavate in the Right-of-Way be obtained by a prequalified contractor. Other conditions of participation will be discussed when participants are selected.
