Explanation of Changes/Revisions:

- Standard 442-The revised standard uses the National format and section headings. No significant revisions were made to the existing standard.
- Standard 450-This is a new National standard and has been adopted with additions to reference state codes.
- Standard 574-The revised standard uses the National format and section headings. No significant revisions were made to the existing standard.
- Standard 576-This is a new National standard and it has been adopted without changes.
- Standard 591-The revised standard uses the National format and section headings. It has been adopted without changes.
- Standard 606-Revised the section on outlet pipe section length (Table 4) to be consistent with the criteria in Standard 620.
- Standard 620-The revised standard uses the National format and section headings. Several sections in the current WI Standard were retained. Revised the section on outlet pipe section length (Table 2) to be consistent with the criteria in Standard 606.
- Construction Specification 300-The soil test for percent fines was added to the section on testing to be consistent with the revised Standard 313, Waste Storage Facility.
